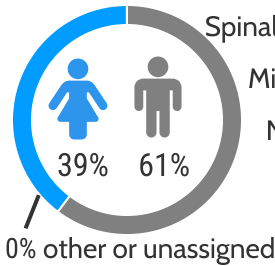

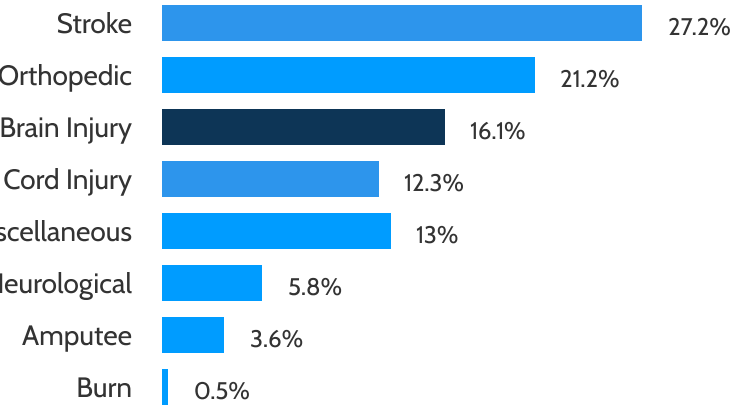

SRH provides expert care for multiple Rehabilitation Impairment Categories.



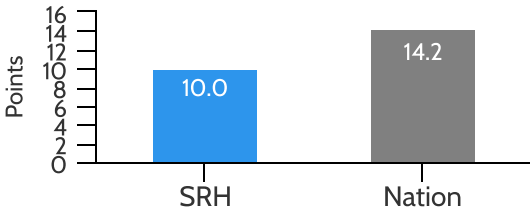
Brain Injury Program: Functional Improvement Quality Measures ¹

Multiple metrics are used to determine patient improvement throughout their inpatient stay. Patients are scored on their admission and again at discharge in the categories of Self-Care and Mobility, which includes multiple skills and abilities as shown in the graphic below. The improvements are measured by the change in score for both and can be compared with similar rehabilitation facilities. **Higher scores are better.**

Eating
Oral hygiene
Toilet hygiene
Shower/bathe self
Upper body dress
Lower body dress
Applying footwear

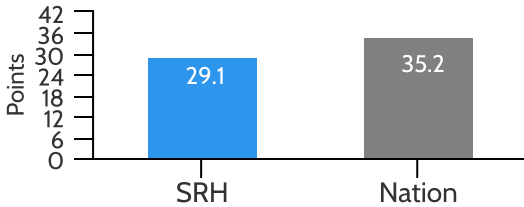
Change in Self-Care Score



Mobility

Rolling, lying down and sitting up in bed
Sit to stand
Transferring to and from bed and chair
Transferring to and from toilet

Change in Mobility Score

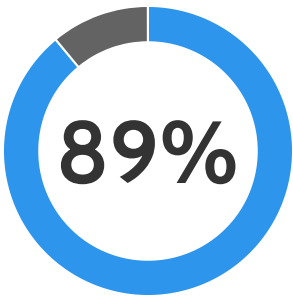


Therapy services are provided at a minimum of 15 hours per week (900 minutes over a rolling 7-day week from admission). All patients receive 24-hour physician & rehab nursing care.

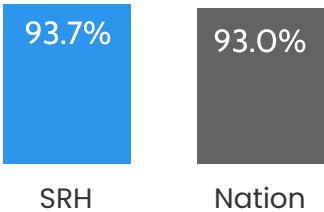
Patient Experience ^{2,3}

At Spaulding Rehabilitation Hospital Boston (SRH), satisfaction with your experience is a high priority. SRH seeks patient feedback to continually improve the patient experience. Patients are surveyed just after discharge and again at 90 days to find out how they are functioning after leaving SRH. **Higher scores are better.**

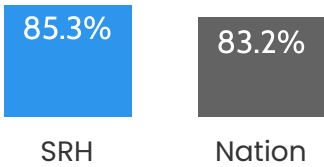
89% of all inpatients would **highly recommend** SRH to friends and family.

Brain Injury Program: The rehabilitation program improved my quality of life



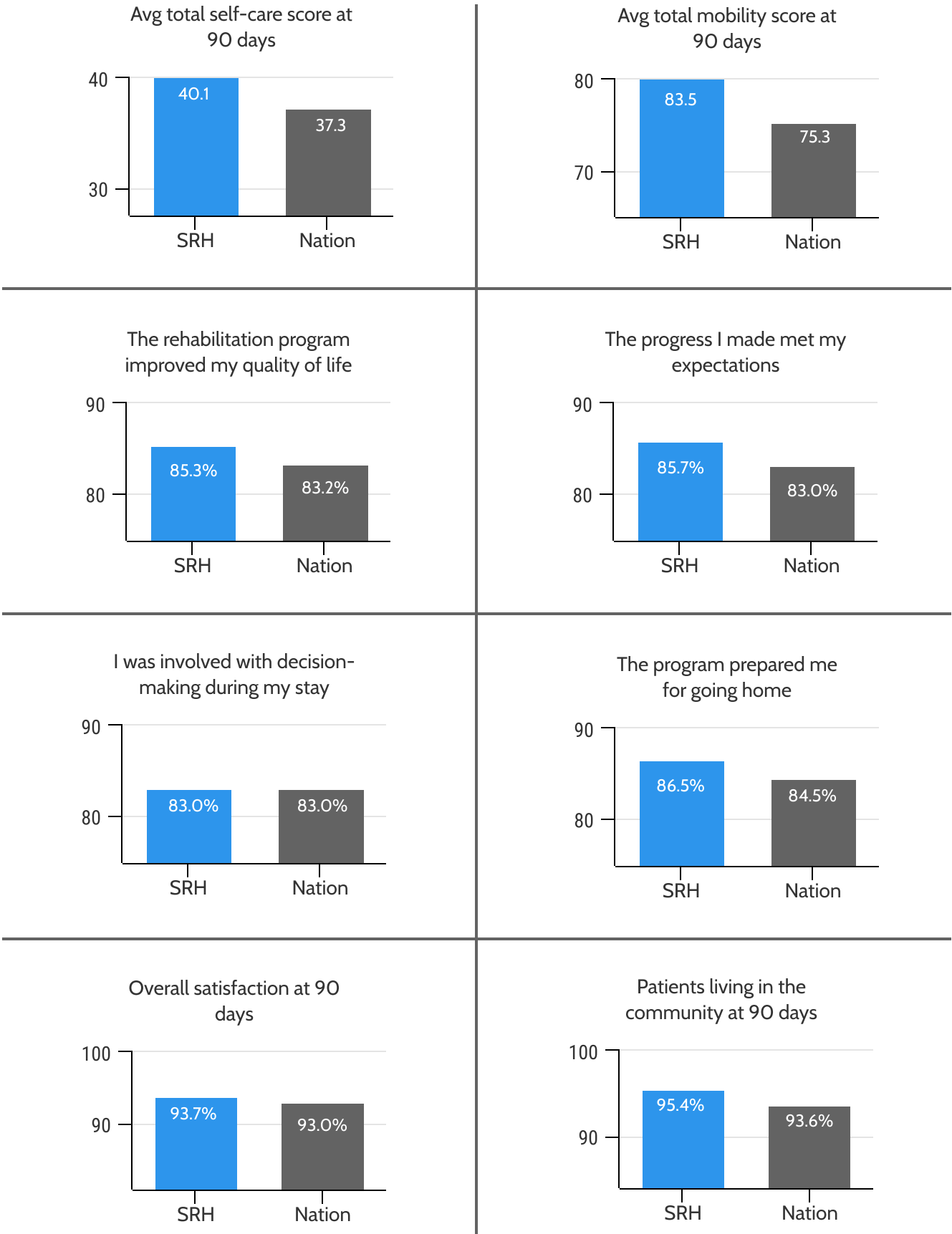

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Maintaining Your Improvement After Discharge²

Spaulding Rehabilitation Hospital Boston (SRH) compares functional performance at discharge from our facility to 90-days post-discharge to assess how our patients are functioning in their home environment. The following categories show SRH against national benchmarks. **Higher scores are better.**



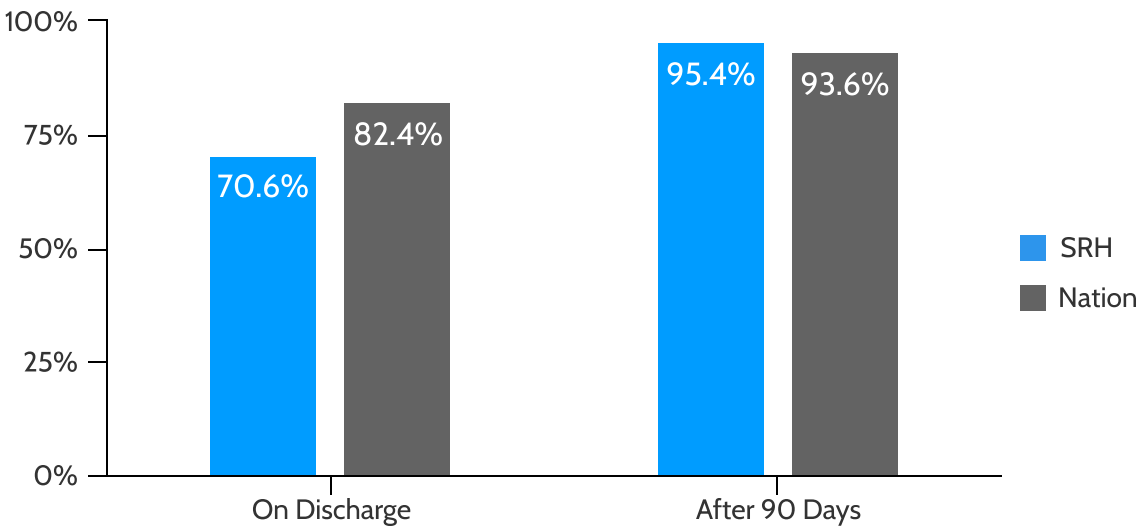
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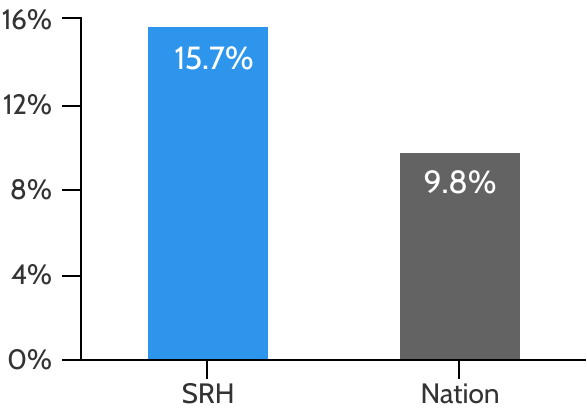
Discharge to Home/Community

Spaulding Rehabilitation Hospital Boston (SRH) discharges patients back to home at a rate below other similar facilities in the nation. 95.4% of SRH Brain Injury Program patients live in the community after 90 days.



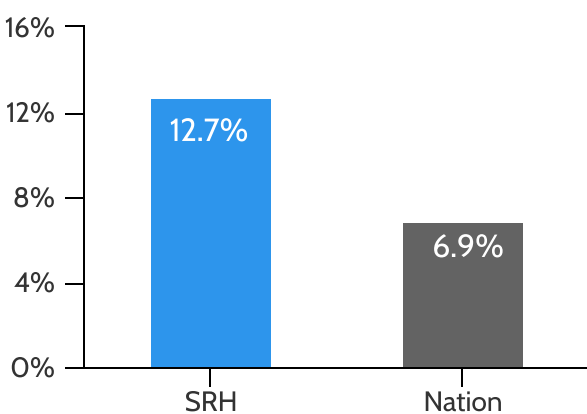
Discharge to Acute Care

SRH discharges patients back to acute care at a rate above other similar facilities in the the nation.



Discharge to Skilled Nursing Facility

SRH discharges patients to skilled nursing facilities at a rate above other similar facilities in the the nation.
